AN illustration booklet on forced removals in the North Coast district of Inanda has recently been published by Durban freelance photographer Omar Badsha.

Entitled *Imijondolo*, this photographic essay reflects the lives, loves and harrowing struggles of the people of Inanda and their bitter battles against forced removals over the years.

Inanda is a massive shack settlement which is home to about a quarter of a million black and Indian people who have been ravaged by disease caused by unhealthy living conditions. Text is by Heather Hughes, a lecturer in the Department of African Studies at the University of Natal.
