1. On Unity and People's War The chickens have come home to roost. Israel, in its igneminous retreat from large tracts of Africa over the past months has decided to strenthen its missions in southern Africa and also to open new ones. It is the close relationship in the military, economic and diplomatic fields between South Africa and Israel that have made the latter to seek succour in the South African fascist state. Israel and South Africa represent a new-type colonialism whereby imperialism transplanted part of its population from the metropolis to these areas. Through crude terreristic methods, the indigenes were repressed and, from London in 1909 and 1917, two decisions were arrived at, the South African Act of Union and the Balfour Declaration, which were instruments of denying the indigenes of the areas their inalienable national rights. Today, these states attempt, by persuasive and coercive tactics, to peddle the idea of "dial -gue" in order to gain legitimacy, whilst also launching aggressive wars to realise this aim. The difference is only in degrees, carret and stick politics hold sway. Legalised terrorism. Each passing day witnesses their isolation, they rot with each passing moment. The rancid smell of their decadence is enveloping mankind. Open the doors and windows of revolution, the liberation movement of Azania and Palestine will bring in the fresh fragrance of peace, justice and a humanity which, without doubt, will be gained, and zealously guarded, through the staccato sound of a machine-gun until imperialism and all other evil forces are no more.
