Dear Mr Pretorius,

Following my discussion with you in Cape Town about the possibility of an Inter-Executive meeting between SASO and NUSAS, the Secretary-General has drawn my attention to Res 44/71; which reads in part as follows:

That this GSC:

- (a) NUSAS: ratifies the Executive decision:
- (i) That there shall be no cooperation with NUSAS on a political platform;
 - (ii) That SASO shall initiate and maintain her own field-work projects independantly of NUSAS and;
 - (iii) That contact shall only be maintained by exchange of research material for academic reasons.

Therefore accept as official there is no further need for Inter-Executive meeting as tentatively hinted; and that the need for exploring and defining our areas of cooperation is at the moment not that urgent.
