Brothers and Sisters,

Our national congress will be held as from the 13th December, 1974 to the 16th December 1974. You are therefore requested to start making preparations so as to be able to report on the 13th December, 1974 for registration, delimitation and orientation. Our last congress was a shamble hence it was not at all productive compared to the first national congress. It becomes imperative that we measure our progress in terms of work done towards completion of the first phase.

PHASE I

POLITICAL DIRECTION:

- a) Principal objective: Liberation from oppression
- b) Immediate engagement: Interpretation of situation
- c) Organisation: (i) Three year membership drive project with one million target.
(ii) Community projects
- d) Philosophical orientation

Branches are urged to conduct workshop to familiarize this phase and execute it. You are further encouraged to hold discussion on policy as well as on the constitution. This should be done with a view of formulating or reviewing policy as well as amendment to the constitution. Discussions should centre around "LIBERATION IN THE SEVENTIES THROUGH SELF-RELIANCE". The venue for this coming congress is still an uncertain issue but notification will come to you during the month of October.

On behalf of the National Executive I wish to inform you that there has been a change in the office-bearers commission. Our Public Relations' Officer, Brother Rev Cooper has resigned his post with effect from the 31st August, 1974. The National Council has elected Brother Harri Singh as acting P.R.O. till congress. Our Secretary-General, Brother Zithulele ka Cindi has been suspended by the National Council till congress. The portfolio of the Sec-Gen. has been combined with that of the National Organiser until congress. Brother Mahlonolapelo wa Skhosana is now conference organiser attached to the office of the National Organiser.


