A detained is therefore allowed to nominate a person whom he wishes to be informed of his / her detention, A notice to this effect is usually convoyed to the detained's nominee either personally, or by means of a registered letter addressed to the nominee.
- 4. For reasons of justice and social policy, primarily in the interests of other members of the community, though occasionally also in the interests of the person so held, this office cannot divulge information indiscreetly and indiscriminately.
