- 1. The legal Xhosa population in the Board area is as follows:-Males : 39 434 Females: 42 617.
- 2. These figures are not broken down into Transkeian Xhosa etc. but represent the total Xhosa population.
- з. There are a total of 15 323 Xhosa householders in after area but again this is an overall "Xhosa" figure.
- 4. As all householders have to be qualified as 10 (1) (a) or (b) to obtain a house, all 15 323 have section 10 rights.
- 5. Greater Soweto:
