AND MORE!

- ▶ Six times (R2.4 million) more money was spent on a few white farmers than millions of poor people.
- ▶ The NP paid government ministers thousands of rands to stay in their own homes. How can they say there is no money to build houses for the homeless?
- ▶ The NP wasted R12 billion on Mossgas - which will never make a profit or benefit the people. This money could have built 342 847 decent homes for our people.
