These anti tank mines (sometimes referred to as anti vehicle mines) represent a random selection of the most common mines that have been found in Southern Africa. Those mines marked \* have been found inside RSA, the others were found in both the Rhodesian (Zimbabwe) and S.W.A. (Namibia) conflict and could appear in the future. These mines are included to assist untrained personnel to identify it as a mine should they be encountered. Anti tank mines are buried below ground level usually on gravel roads and are detonated by the vehicle wheels passing directly over them. (These mines are not necessarily supplied by the country of manufacture.)

**WARNING:** These mines are dangerous. If found do not touch, report them to your nearest police station immediately, inform your superiors and implement laid down evacuation drills.
