

KOORNHOF'S BILLS



In 1984, we are faced with the 1st stages of the implementation of the government's reform package, which includes the constitutional proposals, the Koornhof Bills, 'labour dispensations', and 'educational reform'. These 'reforms' can not and will not do away with the fundamentals of Apartheid. Racial oppression, economic exploitation, the pass laws, the Group Areas Act, all still remain. The majority of people, including all those who the government is trying to co-opt, are still excluded from the power to make real decisions over their lives. In the face of growing and united resistance, the government is attempting to divide, disorganise, co-opt, and control as many of the oppressed as possible. * with the Koornhof Bills, they are trying to drive a wedge between middle class and working class Africans, rural and urban; * the new constitution attempts to divide and colour the 'from Africans'; * 'labour dispensations' are merely new ways to increase the exploitation of the working class; * 'educational reforms' will refine methods of reaching the ruling class ideology of government succeeds in creating disorganisation amongst the oppressed and if the division and disorganisation amongst the oppressed majority, it will help to keep Apartheid going. The concerted unity of all oppressed people and those opposed to Apartheid, is a significant development in the building of a free and just South Africa. Community organisations, trade unions, women, youth, student and religious organisations, are actively opposing the various elements of Apartheid and its reform strategies. The UDF was formed to unite in action all these groupings in opposition to the Constitutional Proposals and the Koornhof Bills. The UDF aims to expose the fraudulent nature of the reforms and to unite in action where the government seeks to divide. The Democratic Action Committee is one of the groupings working with the UDF.

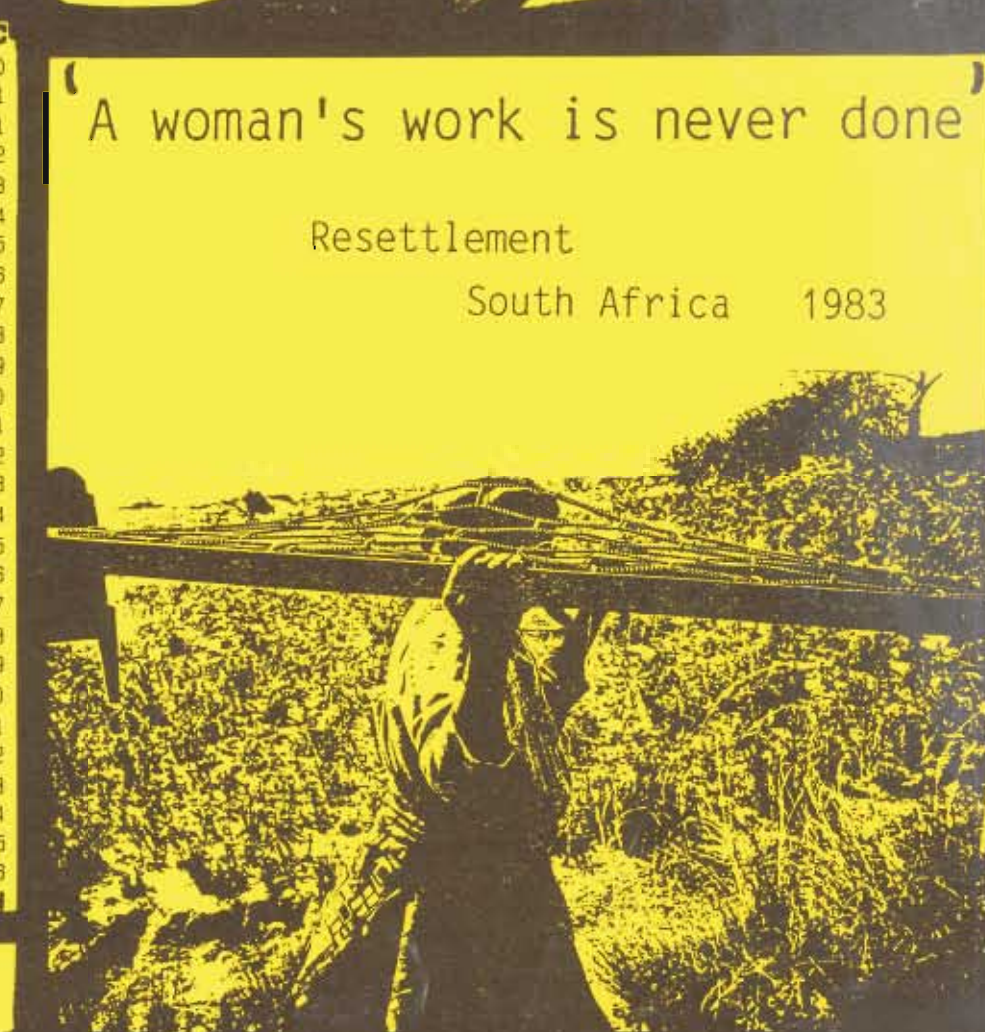
