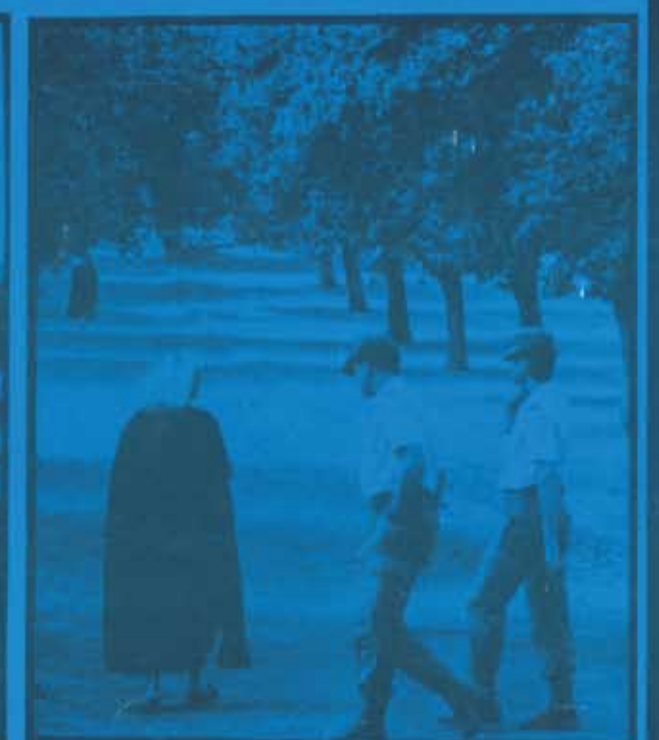


MARCH 30 1988:

80 student delegates from 8 universities, representing over 200 student organizations handed over their petitions condemning the bannings of 18 organizations.

BAN APARTHEID, NOT DEMOCRACY

We condemn the Nationalist Government's recent repressive measures, including the bannings and restrictions of extra-parliamentary organizations and the De Klerk subsidy conditions.

In particular, we condemn the banning of the student organization SANSCO.

These actions offer South Africa no hope of a political solution, but will merely serve to exacerbate and prolong the conflict.

We therefore demand that the government revoke these bannings immediately.
