UNO COMMITTEE BETRAYS OUR PEOPLE

It is part of the known and stated policy of this paper to expose the rôle of the United Nations Organisation as an instrument of the Imperialist nations. We have never ceased to show that the UNO is essentially a weapon in the hands of these Imperialists, led by Britain and America; a weapon used against the oppressed colonial and non-white people of the world; a weapon obstructing their development towards democracy and independence.

In contrast to many other groups from S.W.A., we are not willing to accept a system of UNO Trusteeship. We demand independence now. We know the UNO, through its Specialised Agencies and Special Committees, acts against the people and safeguards the interests of the Imperialist nation. Any UNO presence in S.W.A. will mean therefore that the valuable mines in the country will remain under British and American Imperialist control, and that the profits, so vital to the economic health of our country, will still sail across the oceans to these distant lands. We need only mention the action of the UNO in Katanga to prove our point.

Thus the recent actions of the UNO Special Committee on S.W.A. under the Chairmanship of Mr. Victorio Carpio have effectively served to show how correct our stand is. By its belly-crawling to the S.A. Government, by its nausseating cowardice (so-called diplomacy) and by its deliberate disregard of the expressed wishes of the S.W.A. people, this Committee has proved itself the agent of Imperialism and the opponent of the democratic aspirations of our people. We are not surprised; when Dag Hammarskjold was in South Africa, he had the same attitude.

In terms of the Resolution adopted by the General Assembly, the 7-man Committee under Carpio, was to visit S.W.A. and (in co-operation with the S.A. Government) abolish apartheid, set up a democracy, grant the full franchise to all adults, ensure the withdrawal of S.A. troops and the release of all political prisoners. All this was to have been accomplished by May 1st. However, the Committee has now co-operated so fully with the S.A. Government that only 2 members (the Chairman and Vice-Chairman) have visited S.A. to have talks with Verwoerd and Eric Louw. They are now to visit S.W.A. to see the situation there for themselves. They have forgotten the precise commands given them, and are now acting like the glassy-eyed tourists seduced here by the S.A. Foundation! Carpio has found Dr. Verwoerd "warm and friendly"; shame on you Carpio!

It is clear that Mr. Carpio and Dr. de Alva (Vice-Chairman) are here on behalf of the Special Committee to make a deal with the S.A. Government. They will arrange an agreement satisfactory to both the Imperialists powers and to Verwoerd. All the fine resolutions about democracy for S.W.A. and the full franchise for all, will be forgotten. Possibly Verwoerd will offer Transkeian-type Independence (under the Bantu Authorities) to Ovamboland as a first step to show his "willingness" to guide our people to full independence. We must emphasise that, contrary to all we did hear from the patriotic bars, the non-whites in S.W.A. have much to be thankful for, and that S.A. is doing a great deal to help them. In any case, Carpio will not bring to our country the democratic rights and the freedom from S.A. tyranny that we all demand.

There is a bitter lesson to be learnt by all who have placed their faith in UNO. As always UNO's representative has betrayed the oppressed people; in this case, we have suffered. Because our organisation is not powerful, disciplined, organised and influential enough, we are forced to accept what is

handed down to us. Instead of being able to seize our own independence now, we must tolerate the open collaboration of Mr. Carpio with Verwoerd - against the interests of our people.

All who genuinely desire freedom for all in S.W.A. have much to think about.

DIE VLOEK HET BRAAI AS HEIL - HIER KAN HIE NIE MET STRENGHEDE!

Volgens die "Woordeboek Advertensie" (1/1/42) het die Goud-Wes Afrika Kleurling Organisasie die bewering verstaan dat dit moontlikheid sou staan vir 'n Kleurling te verwant word aan ons omdat ons dat wat in hoedanig geïnteresseerd is, kan wees. Sal ons ons huidig, soek ons hierdie Kleurling-Nederzetting uit tussen gaan bly tot die Kleppers ons is, want die meer van die oorgeste heerlikeheid van kleurling-huisvesting is af Nameka, Swarros of Nameka?

Trekdom is dit baie interessant om op te merk dat die leiers van SWAKO die selfde onderneming is wat tot die Departement van Kleurlingsake behoort is. Die doel van hierdie Departement is om goedheid te bewerk vir 'n ware "Kleurlinge" te sluit met 'n kleurling vrou, met 'n sien kultuur, die roeswou, die skole, die arbeid. 'n die ander van hir, 'n die kleurling-god. Is dit verbaasd dat hierdie landsgoue (want van kleurling reservate kom, soos Gondwandal) hierdie naam met 'n Gondwandal-kleurling saamhou? Enige voorkeur is om Kleurlinge van ons in huis te neem?

Wil ons kleurlinge woon sodat ons vry moet lyk of 'n man bruin is voordat ons met hom kan gesels, voorwaar ons niet hem kan trou. Ons was al die jare geluk gehouwing en net enigtelik te menselik, nie omdat hy swart of bruin is nie, maar omdat ons van die persoonhou en ons interessante vind, omdat ons sy gesels stig gesels of iets van hom kan leer. Waarom moet ons ewig meer word om ons kinders en kleurling- of Nameka-sake te stuur? Waarom moet ons ewig meer word om die kleurling-huise te gesels?

As die Kleurling dieselfde taal, kultuur en oorsprong as die blanke het (volgens SWAKO) waarom is dit nodig vir die Kleurling en in 'n Kleurling-lokasie te wonn en nie ons net die blanke woon nie? Kan SWAKO nie die teenstrydigheid in hierdie argument rukken nie? Is dit hoe 'n Kleurling-brain redeneer?

Die leiers van SWAKO is so naef dat hulle nog kan sê dat hulle by die witman sal steen, huig of bars, "we will sink and swim together ..." vir wie se voordeel? Sal ons dan met die manne staan wat ons die heilid in die warm son lêt werk, die manne wat ons so min betaal dat ons kinders moet sterf van honger en ellende, of van siekte? Sal ons met die manne staan wat ons so min betaal dat ons arme kindertjies moet bibber en beef van die koue in die skool, omdat

Matter verlike nie-blanke man vandag opstaan en vir ons vertel dat hy dieselfde is as die witman en in dieselfde assentuig kan vra vir 'n aparte woonplek en 'n aparte kultuur?

Vir ons is dit so onsaak dat SWAKO kan sê dat "we are brothers and should go forward together" en terselfdertyd kan sê dat die belang van die Kleurling in die blanke teenstrydig met nemmer is. So hulle nie dat die wit manne meer geld verdien en dus die Kleurling-meisies makliker kan okskoop en verlei nie? Kan SWAKO nie besef dat hulle salartses laer is as die van die witman omdat apartheid dit veroorsaak? Hulle geniet nie dieselfde regte as die blankes, omdat hulle nie die reg het om weg te staan in ons land nie.

Die witman is gou om te sien dat die Kleurling sy broer is dat die Kleurling beter is as die Afrikaner as hy (die witman) hom nodig het. Die blankes is net besig om die Kleurling te bereik, hy sal nog nosit die Kleurling gelyke regte gee nie. Die blankes besef dat as die Kleurling en die Afrikaner moet veronig, die dae van Herrenvolkisme (wit dominasie), apartheid, hongersnood en lyding getel is!

Wanneer sal die Kleurlinge besef dat hulle onder dieselfde juk gebuk gaan as die Afrikaner? Wanneer sal hulle besef dat Herrenvolkisme hulle grootste vyand is? Wanneer sal hulle besef dat hulle hulle lot by die Afrikaner moet swerf en die Vryheidsbeweging vir onmiddellike Demokrasie en gelyke regte vir almal moet ondersteun tot die bitter einde? Wanneer sal die Kleurlinge veg vir dié reg om ~~HEIL~~ te wees?

Die tyd word kort as ons nie met die magtige Wind van Verandering wat oor die hele kontinent van Afrika waai, saam gely nie, sal ons vir ewig sigte wees in ons land. Laat ons of mehetjieblind word deur die vuil skottelgoed water wat SWAKO en die Departement van Kleurlingsake ons in die gesig smyt nie. BLIGNAUT REJECTED IN OVAMBOLAND

We have reported in our previous edition how the people are rallying behind SWAPO in their struggle against the S.A. Government.

We are pleased therefore to make public the fact that our people have once again demonstrated their rejection of the S.A. government's undemocratic schemes.

Mr. Blignaut (Chief native Commissioner of S.W.A.) has held a series of meetings at major centres in Ovamboland. At each gathering he tested the people's reaction to a Transkeian-type "independence" plan (that is more power to the chiefs under Bantu Authorities. Power to control and punish our people according to Verwoerd's laws). And at every gathering he was firmly opposed. With one voice our people told him, "We do not want a Bantustan. We want the S.A. Government to go!"

SWAPO spokesmen led the attack on Blignaut at every meeting - in spite of the danger they face when they speak in public. We commend them on their courage, and urge them to press on and demand INDEPENDENCE NOW!

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MORE PRESSURE ON OLD-LOCATION DWELLERS.

In terms of a recent decision all Non-European employees of the Windhoek Municipality at present resident in the Old-Location have been given three months in which to move to Katutura.

This vicious regulation, designed to force all who in principle oppose being herded and treated like cattle, will affect 235 men.

In spite of the fact that for some, Katutura is closer to their place of work, and in spite of the extra R50 per year that Katutura-resident employees of the Municipality receive, our people still resolutely refuse to move.

We support them in their opposition to all apartheid-inspired locations. We condemn the Municipality for the numerous unscrupulous schemes it has in operation which compel our people to trek!

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XXXXXX We consider it a NATIONAL DISASTER that so many of our people have been tricked into giving evidence to Mr. Carpio, Chairman of the UNO Committee on South West Africa! Mr. Carpio will now say, "I have consulted Dr. Verwoerd. Here is my judgement: The S.A. Government appears to be doing a great deal of good in South West Africa. UNO should not interfere too much in the future. We should give Dr. Verwoerd a chance to see if his plans will work out!"

The country should not be placed under UNO trusteeship at this stage!

Our people, because they have been consulted, will accept such a judgement. We must be careful. This is the danger of working with UNO - we can be misled into accepting decisions that betray our struggle for Freedom and Independence.

We call upon our people to demand INDEPENDENCE NOW!! To forget about begging UNO to take over control of our country and to join the liberatory Movement IMMEDIATELY!!!

WINDHOEKERS EXCITED - OVER WHAT?

We have noted with much interest the controversy raging among our people over the new Coloured Location in Windhoek. According to recent reports, about 500 people at a meeting called by the Windhoek Coloured Parent-Teacher Association, voiced strong disapproval of the scheme. The audience showed fervent support for a scheme whereby they could buy plots and build their own houses. (At present the Municipality controls the building of new houses - for sale to Coloured persons).

We are not very impressed. The fundamental question of the rejection of aparte locations in principle was never raised. NO attempt was made to oppose all locations (African and Coloured). The gathering apparently decided to demand further negotiation with the administrator - and this is the great tragedy!

We must not (by negotiations, deputations and discussions) ASSIST the administration in implementing Group Areas and Locations. We must demand to live where we please: to the racialists let us say, do your own dirty work, we shall not move on our own, and we shall not help you to move us.

APRIL 2nd BLACK DAY FOR S.W.A.

WILING COUNCIL TO BE INAUGURATED

On April 2nd, the new Coloured Advisory Council for S.W.A. will be inaugurated. The nine persons who have thus far been chosen to represent the Coloured people of S.W.A., together with another five undesirable persons will commence their unpleasant duties.

What are their tasks? To convince us that we have actually some say in the Government of this country.

What is we require? We require freedom from apartheid, from locations, from low wages, insults and poverty! Can they give us this? Of course not. They are but servants who have to carry out the commands of their white masters. If they do not do this, they will be dismissed.

They have not been elected in a democratic fashion - we do not even have the vote. They have been chosen by the Government - agents - and we are to believe that they represent us and we have confidence in them.

Let us make our stand quite clear. We want the full franchise (to elect and to be elected) and a democratic parliament. We want to have people in authority who have been chosen by us and whom we respect. We reject this new puppet-body, and we brand as traitors all who serve on it. We call upon all interested in the liberation of S.W.A. to work so that it lies an early death!
