The South African Government intends to hang Moses Mnyanda Jantjes and Mlamli Wellington Mialis tomorrow, September 1, 1987. Both Moses and Mlamli have denied the charge for which your Government intends to hang them for. These two young men are, like many others, freedom fighters against the evil system of apartheid. Once again your government chooses to eliminate opponents of apartheid rather than dismantling the entire system as the international community and the majority of South Africans demand.

How long can your government continue to ignore the wishes of the majority in South Africa? The programme to combat racism of the World Council of Churches appeals to you to stay the execution and grant reprieve to Moses and Mlamli.
