

# SOUTH AFRICAN YOUTH

## The Freedom Charter

as adopted at the Congress of the People on June 26, 1955

### The people shall govern.

Every man and woman shall have the right to determine and decide in accordance with the law which makes laws.

All the people shall be entitled to take part in the administration of the country.

The rights of the people shall be the same regardless of race, colour or sex.

All bodies of men and women, religious bodies, associations and federations shall be permitted to determine the affairs of their groups.

### All national groups shall have equal rights.

There shall be equal status in the bodies of state, in the church and in the schools for all national groups and races.

All national groups shall be protected by the government to their own national needs.

All people shall have equal rights to use their own language and to develop their own folk culture and religion.

The promotion and practice of racism, racialism, racialism and colonialism shall be a punishable offence.

All punishment known and practice shall be abolished.

### The people shall share in the country's wealth.

The natural wealth of our country, the heritage of all South Africans, shall be owned by the people.

The natural wealth beneath the soil, the banks and monopoly industries shall be transferred to the ownership of the people as a whole.

All other labour and tools shall be controlled by control the well-being of the people.

All people shall have equal rights to trade where they choose, to manufacture and to earn all their合法的 profits.

### The land shall be shared among those who work it.

Ownership of land especially on a rural basis shall be collectivized and all the land cultivated among those who work it, to benefit those and land labour.

The state shall help the peasants with implements, seeds, animals and funds to save the soil and trees of Africa.

Plots of land shall be guaranteed to each work on the land.

All shall have the right to occupy and administer their homes.

PROCLAMATION: We, the people of South Africa, believe in one country and all that we hold dear:

That South African technology for all who live here in Africa and abroad, and there are governments and people whose authority must be based on the will of the people;

That every person born here is entitled to equality and the right to live, liberty and justice before a system of government founded on separation and inequality. That every country should control its government, or that until all our people have been born, uniting equal rights and opportunities;

That only a democratic state, based on the will of the people, can secure in all these blessings a better administration of justice, law, and order; and therefore, we the people of South Africa, black and white, together create, constitute and form the South African Freedom Charter. And we pledge ourselves to total segregation, separating nothing of our strength and resources, until the democratic changes we have been born again.
