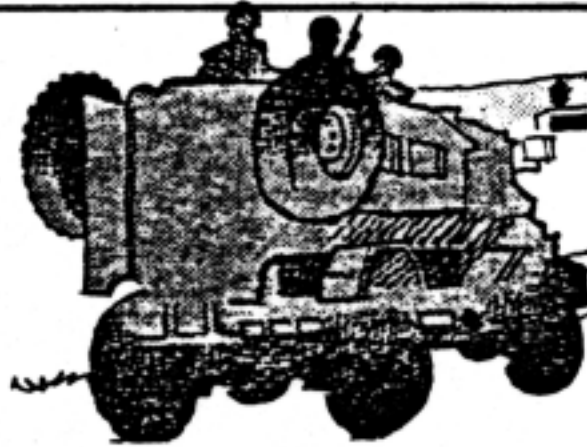

## SHARPEVILLE 1960 LANGA 1985

26 years ago, on March 21 1960, hundreds of unarmed people throughout S.A. were killed and wounded by police when they offered themselves up for arrest in protest at the pass laws.

The call for the start of each year's campaign on March 21 1960 came from the Pan Africanist Congress (P.A.C.).

Last year Sharpeville Day was commemorated into our history of resistance when mourners of the police in Langa in the Eastern Cape, on March 21, 1985.
