**STOP PRESS**

Paris, 17-year-old son of Saul Mkhize, has laid a charge against the Piet Retief police alleging he was taken from a bus, asked why his father was resisting the removal from Driefontein, and beaten so badly that he lost his glass eye. He says he was threatened with what seemed to be a welding torch, made to lie down while a car was driven to within an inch of his neck, and kept overnight in the local police cells.

His civilian-clad assailants, seven black and one white, allegedly showed him their police identification cards.
