That the B.P.C. branch of Johannesburg Central Meeting:


1. The struggle of the people of Namibia (S.W.A.) as against the white racist regime of South Africa to fragment them into Bantustans.

4. That the stand of the Namibians is the B.P.C. policy in its true perspective.
