
RE-INSTATE ALL DISMISSED WORKERS!

Workers! Did you see the danger. Because we saw the danger. The bosses already used the bill against us.


We say to all our comrades: You must also feel strong. Come together. Unite. Come to us. We must make one unity to fight the bill.
