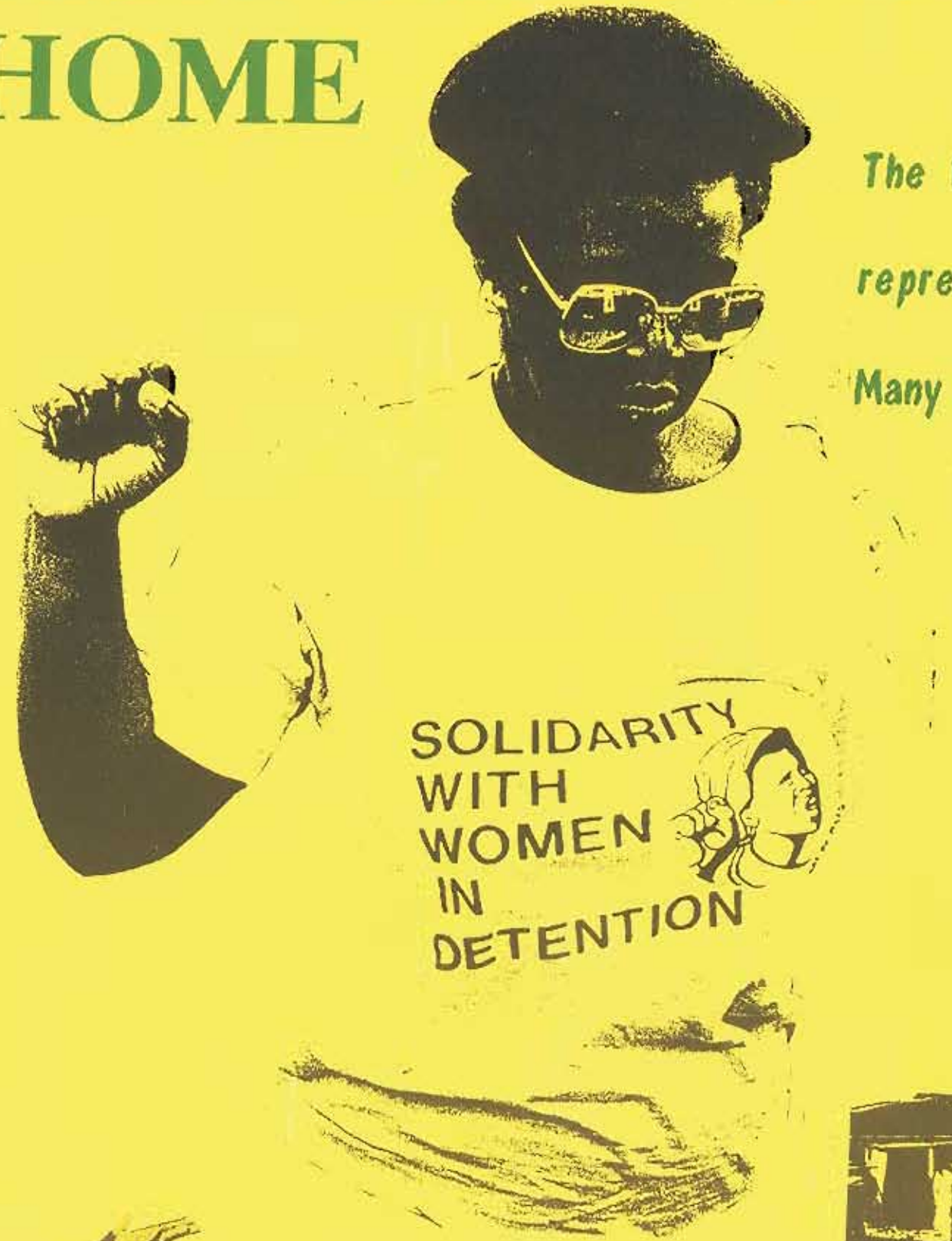


# WOMEN ORGANISING FOR CHANGE
