“ . . . the Nazi student association emerged as the leading force in the German universities (and in Austria) in 1930, well before Hitler had become the leader of the strongest German party . . . The declared aim of the Nazi student association was to destroy liberalism and international capitalism; point two on its programme was to “purge the university of the influence of private capital”; point nine called on the students to join the ranks of the workers. The slogan of “student power” . . . was linked to the demand that the university be made political, a real “people’s university”, . . . ”
