COSATU and the UDF continue to work for peace and stability in the Pietermaritzburg townships. We are prepared to have talks but for these to work we say:

1. STOP DETAINING OUR LEADERS

Sikhumbuzo Ngwenya and Martin Wittenberg, the joint UDF Secretaries and about 13 other key youth leaders were detained at a meeting at which peace was being discussed. Their detention is a severe setback for peace. If the talks are going to work, the authorities must stop these detentions.

2. ALLOW US TO FREELY CONSULT WITH OUR **MEMBERS**

In the past few days our efforts to consult with our members and supporters have been severely disrupted. Individuals centrally involved in the peace process have been detained and meetings have been broken up by the police. Peace talks at a leadership level mean nothing — we must take the community with us. Unless we are freely allowed to organise openly, the peace process will be meaningless.

3. ARREST THE PERPETRATORS OF VIOLENCE

Lawyers carried out a month-long investigation which clearly pointed to who was involved in the violence. Although these suspects, who are linked to Inkatha, have been identified most have still not been arrested and are free to roam about the townships.

4. END THE FORCED RECRUITMENT

The violence is directly linked to the forced recruitment by the warlords. This must stop. All organisations must be allowed equal freedom to organise.

5. DISCIPLINE

All organisations must discipline members guilty of aggression.

6. NO TO THE ARMY

The ordinary police must act against the known culprits. They can easily do this. Bringing in more police and the army will only increase tension.

TO ACHIEVE PEACE COSATU AND UDF HAVE:

- 1. Taken legal steps to protect victims of the violence.
- 2. Issued pamphlets and press statements urging our followers to restrain themselves.
- 3. Tried to hold meetings with our members.
- 4. Met with the churches, the Chamber of Commerce, representatives from the PFP and the National Democratic Movement and representatives of overseas governments.
