INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY

On March 8, 1908, American socialist women demonstrated in New York against the middle-class suffrage movement. At the Second

Conference of Socialist Women in Copenhagen in 1910, Clara Zetkin, a leading Russian Socialist, proposed that this day be designated as "International Women's Day" in the Socialist movement. The purpose of the

day was to mobilise more women workers for the cause of socialism and revolution. The proposal was accepted and since 1911, the day has been celebrated around March 8 in most countries.
