

Plan for township scrapped

THE Cape Midlands Administration Board decided at a meeting yesterday to scrap plans to develop an African township at Klipfontein, a farm near Bushman's River Mouth.

The plans for a consolidated township for Africans from Boknes, Kenton-on - Sea, Bushman's River Mouth and Cannon Rocks, were shelved because of objections from agricultural organisations, the Bushman's River Ratepayers' Association, and the Department of Forestry.

Another reason for the scrapping of the plan was the Dias Divisional Council's proposed development of a coloured township at Klipfontein.

The board decided that squatters now at Klipfontein and the emergency camp at Kenton - on - Sea should be moved to Glenmore, a proposed settlement site on the Fish River, near Committees Drift.
