REPORT ON COMRADE MOOSAJEE

I am told by a reliable supporter of the Movement, who is prepared to testify if called upon, that Comrade Moosajee has acquired property of considerable value in London and Francetown, Botswana.

There is suspicion backed by evidence that the funds for the property were accumulated at the expense of the Movement

The matter was brought to the notice of the TG in 1980 and the President in 1981. I am also told that Comrade Mac is also aware of the alleged situation

Moosajee himself said in August 1982 that he would welcome an inquiry into the properties and his accounts

I forward this report without comment to appropriate quarters for information
