REQUEST ON THE RELEASE OF POLITICAL PRISONERS

On O7 August 1987 the Japanese Government conveyed to the South African Consul-General in Tokyo the following demarche:

"The Japanese Government deplores the recent detention of UDF leaders by the South African Government, as the move counters the Japanese Government's contention that apartheid has to be urgently abolished by negotiation and dialogue.

The Japanese Government repeatedly seeks from the South African Government a release of all political prisoners including Nelson Mandela, and urges the South African Government to make an accelerated effort in bringing about negotiated settlement through talks."
