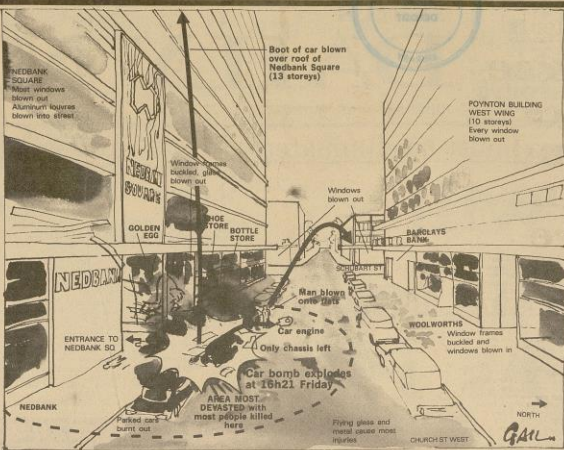
Prominent academics yesterday claimed Friday's bombing blast in Pretoria is a warning to the Government to consider the exclusion of blacks from top-level political decision-making.
