# EXPLO SIVES ON CAPE RAIL BRIDGE

THREE MEN allegedly fled from explosives planted on the rail bridge across the Orange River at Upington when they were surprised by a railways employee at 8.35am on Friday.

A search was launched at the weekend and the airport, used daily by several South African Airways jets, was closely guarded.

A veil of official secrecy has descended and by mid-morning today Railway Police public relations sources refused to confirm or deny wide-ranging allegations about the matter.

They confirmed only that explosives were found on the bridge, about a kilometre from Upington, on the line to De Aar which connects the rail network to Namibia, and that they were removed.
